Minutes of the Annual General Meeting of the Poole Yacht Racing Association held at the Poole Yacht Club on November 24th 2020

1. Present: -

2. Apologies for absence: -

3. Report on the past season by the Association Captain.

Rob reported that PYRA had another great season in 2019 and highlighted two events for mention; the Easter Tour (Solent Hop) and PYRA on tour. He also picked out two RVs for mention; the sponsorship by Port Chantereyne of the Cherbourg weekend and the RV at Portland organised by Roger Bond.

4. To receive and approve the Accounts

The balance sheet and Income and Expenditure Account had been circulated prior to the meeting (See Attached).

The treasurer explained that the Year End had been changed to the end of September in order to remove the confusion caused by the candlelight dinner monies being received before the end of year but without the corresponding candlelight outgoing being paid. The meeting was told that there had been a small net increase in the overall balance compared with last year.

The meeting approved the accounts.

5. Election of the Association Captain for 2020

Resolution (Item 8)

Class 4 to declare the VPRS sail plan on a per series basis.

Objective

To allow Class 4 members to sail effectively for a season in all the different series of races.

Proposal

To amend Red Book Part 2 Section 2.4 Identification of Class - NOTES Class 4 to read-

Class 4:

Mono-hull Class 4: Ideal for couples, shorthanded or newcomers to racing - Straightforward Bay, Coastal and Channel racing in company - very good company!

If a declaration has been received that a spinnaker will not be used for a series before 1200 hr on the Wednesday prior to the day of the first race of the series concerned, or, in the case of a race which starts on a Friday, the Tuesday before, this will be noted on the Class 4 class list and the no spinnaker TCC rating will be used for the whole of the series, otherwise TCC will be used.

If more than three persons are on board over the age of 7 years during a race each additional crew will incur a 5% time penalty per person. The number on board to be reported with the finishing time.

Crew will be counted as 8 years old, or older, if they attained the age of 8 before the 1st September of the preceding PYRA sailing season (as per school years).

Resolution (Item 9)

Shortening Course

Objective

When a course is set with intermediate marks where times are taken, often the fastest boat in the class will make one waypoint further than the rest of the fleet. This leads to just one boat being credited with a finish time and the rest of the class being marked as dnf. The objective of this resolution is to reduce the number of dnfs when intermediate mark times are used for results.

Proposed – Matt Hitt

Seconded - Committee

Proposal

a) The race committee/class captain or representative should make every effort to set a course that is likely to enable the vast majority of the class to complete it

b) The course may be shortened during the race by the race committee/class captain or representative elected before the warning signal for that class at a predetermined waypoint, and shall be announced via VHF

c) In the event that the course is not shortened and intermediate timing marks have been included in the course, positions shall be awarded in "flights" ie boats reaching the furthest intermediate waypoint shall be

awarded positions 1-3, the next waypoint back, places 4-6 and so on. Boats failing to reach any intermediate waypoint shall be scored dnf.

d) In the event that sailing instruction c) applies, competitors need only declare the time for the furthest waypoint they reached, but must state clearly in their declaration which waypoint they got to.

Resolution (Item 10)

Class 1 to use Auto-Helm during the two handed races

Objective

To allow us to both race the boats harder and bring us into line with most 2 handed racing.

To amend Red Book Part 2 Section 8.2 to read -

Automatic Steering

The use of automatic or mechanical steering devices shall be permitted for passage races. In the Two Handed Series its use is permitted for Class 1 but not for any other class.

Objective

To move the AGM forward to January to avoid the congestion caused by all of the Prize Givings, plus the Candle Light Dinner and Club Christmas Dinners during November and the first two weeks of December.
