## SPECIAL NOTICE of RACE

September 12<sup>th</sup> /13<sup>th</sup> – Poole –Yarmouth-Poole (Race Nos. 9 + 10) and

September. 26<sup>th</sup> /27<sup>th</sup> – Poole-Beaulieu-Poole (Race Nos. 11+12)

### 1. STATEMENT OF RISK

This Notice of Race should be read in conjunction with the standard NoR published in the Red Book.

All racing will be held in compliance with the guidelines set out by Public Health England and the RYA and may be subject to, last minute, change.

Crew composition must comply with Government guidance on social distancing and mixing of persons from more than one household bubble.

*What's Currently Allowed / Event Guidance:*

*“Up to six people from different households can mix in the open air while maintaining the correct social distance”.*

*“People from a maximum of two household bubbles can mix indoors maintaining social distancing”.*

*“Correct Social Distance is 2 metres where possible otherwise 1 metre PLUS”.*

### 2. SELF SUFFICIENCY AND SAFETY

You must carry all equipment to be self-sufficient as required. The means of hand washing and sanitising on board should be adequate for everyone. Life jackets shall be worn at all times, including pre and post-race, from leaving until returning to dock to reduce personal risk. PYRA boats should be especially vigilant and be prepared to assist other competitors in order to avoid the risk of an emergency call out.

### 3. ENTRIES, CLASSES AND RATINGS.

All boats will race as a single class subdivided into two. One subdivision for those intending to use a spinnaker (WS - 2020 VPRS TCC will be used for results) and the other subdivision for those that have declared by 12:30 on the Wednesday before the race that they will not be using a spinnaker (NS - 2020 VPRS No spinnaker TCC will be used for results).

A class flag shall be flown to show that the boat is racing.

**Boats should enter via the PYRA web site in the normal way and monitor the website until the last opportunity before the event in case of changes.**

#### **4. PRIZES & PRIZEGIVING**

**These “special” races will not count for PYRA points and will not be part of a series. There will be no trophies or annual awards but prizes will be awarded at the next formal (permitted) gathering of members.**

#### **5. WEATHER.**

**With due regard to the potential involvement of emergency services, at the Race Officer’s discretion, racing may be cancelled if forecast winds are above 20 knots.**

#### **6. GENERAL WARNINGS**

**Bearing in mind the unusual circumstances, entrants are requested to be especially considerate of other competitors and be mindful of the public perception of sporting activity and the practical safety issues arising from the Covid 19 pandemic. Competitors are advised to use personal travel in arriving and departing from their boat wherever possible.**

**Any person exhibiting symptoms of Covid 19, or who suspects that they may be at high risk of infection, through contact or particular vulnerability are specifically requested not to sail**

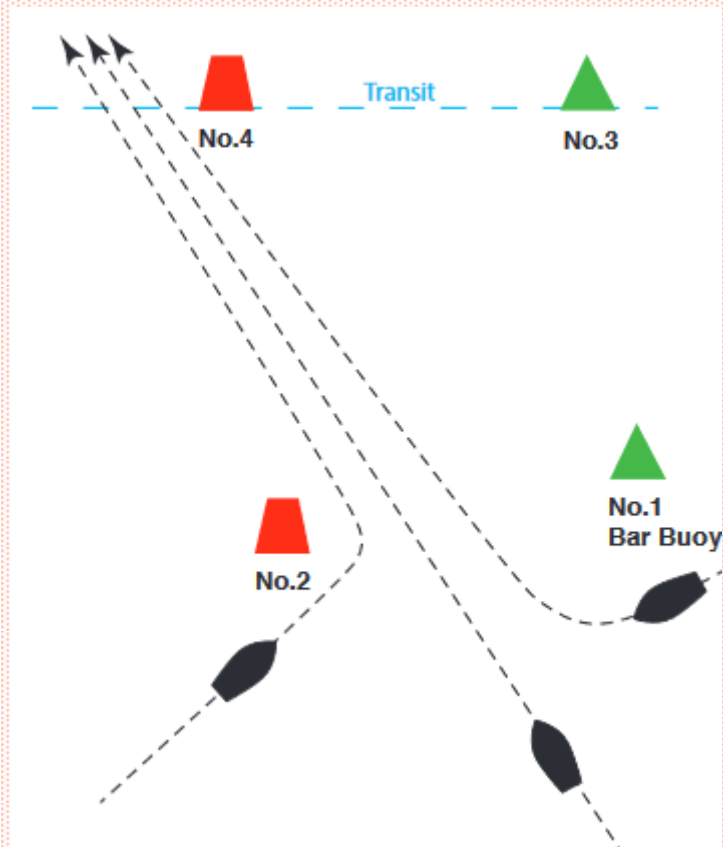
