Minutes of the Annual General Meeting of the Poole Yacht Racing Association held via Zoom on January 20th 2021

3. Report on the past season by the Association Captain.

Rob' s report is attached . The report reminds us that, despite the arrival of Corvid19 in February, PYRA managed to arrange some events to save our sailing season once the first lockdown eased. The programme was made up of five weekends of round the Cans racing in Poole Bay and then two weekends following our more usual structure, racing to Yarmouth and then Beaulieu. The rendezvous at Yarmouth (Royal Solent Yacht Club) and Beaulieu (an evening at Bucklers Hard) were the only two social events that survived in 2020. The first social event casualty was the spring party which resulted in some of our regular members missing the opportunity to renew their membership and as a result membership numbers were down in 2020 but it was good to see a number of new members join.

4. To receive and approve the Accounts

The balance sheet and Income and Expenditure Account had been circulated prior to the meeting (See Attached).

The treasurer noted that income for the year was down compared to 2019 but expenditure was also down so the balance for the year was similar to 2019.
