1ST, 2ND AND 3RD MAY 2021 NOTICE OF RACE and RACE INSTRUCTIONS

Entries will be accepted from any PYRA member.

All entrants shall comply fully with; RYA Guidance on sailing & racing with participants from different households during COVID-19 in England.

There shall be no gathering ashore. Results for races 1 and 2 will be announced on Zoom at 19.30 on the 2nd May.

Entries may be split into three classes: Classes 1 & 2 dependant on their VPRS rating plus a Non-Spinnaker class.

Day 1 (1st May) Will comprise; Practice Starts plus a practice 'Windward-Leeward' race with 'Off Boat' Coaching by a team of Expert Sailors. First Start 13.00 BST

Day 2 (2nd May) Will comprise two windward-leeward races in Poole Bay. Race 1, first start will be at 11.00. Race 2 will start soon after the completion of race 1.

Committee Boat for Days 1&2 will be a Harrier an Elan 36 displaying a PYRA flag. Communications will be as noted in the Red Book. Start sequences will be broadcast on the day.

Day 3 (3rd May) will be the 'Navigator's Challenge', for the fastest corrected time passing the following three marks in any order, within 2 boat lengths:

Pass to the South West of Tony Brookes (ex Chalys).

To the South East of Magnum (ex Perenco)

To the North East of Bournemouth.

Competitors shall self-start using the Swash line between 09.30 and 11.00 and then self-finish on the Poole Finish Line. Start and finish times must be lodged with the Results secretary by 14.00 on the $3^{\rm rd}$ May.

In the case of adverse weather racing may be postponed or cancelled at the discretion of the race committee.

All racing will take place in Poole Bay and all entries shall comply with World Sailing and PYRA requirements for Inshore Racing.

This Notice of Race and Race Instructions shall be read in conjunction with the Red Book.
