

NOTICE OF RACE

PYRA TOUR 2022

28TH MAY THROUGH 5TH JUNE

The Tour Fleet will hopefully head south in 2022. First to Alderney and then to cruise through the Channel Isles, possibly as far as St Malo. However, as with all previous Tours, the final decision on destination rests with the Tour Committee (ie made up of participating Skippers) who will decide on the next destination the evening before each race.

There will be a briefing for all competitors at Poole Yacht Club, 19.30 on Friday the 27th May when the destination for Race 1 will be set and the start time confirmed. Sailing Instructions with Finish Line information will be available at the briefing

Race 1 on the 28th May will be part of the PYRA Passage series and is open to all PYRA members. Subsequent Tour races will not be part of the PYRA passage series.

Race 1 Start will not be before 06.00 on 28th May.
Start Line will be the Swash Start Line.

The Tour will be raced under World Sailing OSR category 4 plus PYRA special requirements.

Anchoring off may be necessary. All boats must ensure they have good, long ground tackle.

Competitors' attention is drawn to the UK Border Force Requirements for Leisure Vessels leaving and entering UK waters. Similarly Competitors must be aware of current entry requirements and necessary documentation for entering overseas waters/ports.
